
to take advantage of. Below is a list of our schedule of events. Try to plan your season, so that we can attend each of our events. We want to make sure our courts are well

THE FOUR DEAD COURT REPORT

HISTORY BIO

In keeping with our celebration of history, I am going to highlight a player that had roots right here in Brownsville, Edmonson County:

LEONARD ESTIL SALINGS





Len was born May 21st, 1937, in Edmonson County to Elnora and Eugene Estel Salings. When Len was seven years old, the family moved north to Jefferson County. When Len was 17, he joined the U.S. Army and was sent to Germany for two years. Len would return to Louisville to start his career, working for a printing company and later on, working for Louisville Gas & Electric until he retired in 1996. Len was a very tough horseshoe pitcher. Although he did pitch multiple tournaments in various seasons of the KHPA, he made one lone Championship appearance in the Men's Division in 1987. Len finished in 5th place at 5-4, averaging 61.1%. Len's high game in the event was 80.6%. Other outings for Len, that showed his skill level was in 1982, Class A Champion of the Culvertown Open. Len was 5-0 with an average of 69.3%. Also in 1982, Len was Champion of the Millville Open with a 69% average, rising above some of the state's best champions, Ed Henry, Stan Lovelace, Rube Blevins, Jim Noble, and others. Len was also active in bowling, cornhole and shooting pool. He was a collector of knives and coins and very active in his church. He had 3 sons and 3 daughters. Len passed away on May 11th, 2016, at 78 years of age. Len is buried at the Poteet Cemetery in Edmonson County.


