LEGEND: (Box below the player photo.)

First Row: Player's Name

Second Row - Player's Status

BLACK - If the player has "passed on", this row will contain their birth year and death year, if known.

"INACTIVE/RETIRED"- BLUE is a player that is still living or in some case, status unknown. The "retired" is dropped for Junior players.

"ACTIVE" - GREEN is a current player of the KHPA.

"SEMI-ACTIVE"- BROWN is a player of the KHPA that has played some in recent years but is not a current m2023 member of the KHPA.

"MOVED" - RED is any of the "living" player status codes above but are currently not living in the state of Kentucky. They may or may not no longer pitch. Deceased players will not be noted as "moved".

Third Row – Most frequent residence "hometown" of the player while they pitched in the KHPA. Any deceased player that moved to another state will only be noted with the hometown of which they resided when they pitched in Kentucky.

This listings on the Pitcher's Archive grid table are the last name letter, followed by the number of players in that file. Example: "A-18" is alphabetized players of the letter A, 18 players listed.
